The Results

- Oil drain intervals were extended from 7,500 to 10,000 miles
- Average fuel economy improvement was **12.8%**
- The 2013-2014 school year proved the savings covered the cost of the oil and also left a net profit. The fuel cost for the 2012-2013 school year was \$35,896 and for the 2013-2014 school year was \$31,819 for a savings of \$4,077 (12.8%).
